The review of *The Hurricane* is generally excellent. I appreciate its reference to the social and political dimensions of the real story. Their near total omission from the film, coupled with the familiar endorsement of

the system which, apparently, never allows the oppressed any means of achieving justice save passive spiritual transcendence, must be considered before making any final judgment of the work.

Reviewer J. Cooper writes that *The Hurricane* doesn't tell us that subsequent to Judge Sarokin's 1985 ruling, the prosecution appealed the case all the way to the US Supreme Court. The film *does* present this information, albeit through the minimal means of a title card displayed just prior to the closing credits.
