

SEP Public Meetings: The Breakdown of Capitalism and the Fight for Socialism in the US

State and local governments are responding with mass layoffs, pay cuts and the elimination of basic social programs.

As popular opposition and anger grows, the response of the political establishment is to move to the right. After bailing out the banks, the Obama administration has rejected any serious measures to address the social crisis. Regardless of the outcome of the November elections, the Democrats and Republicans are preparing a new wave of austerity measures for the working class.
