

Video: Australian steel workers face deep job cuts

Steel workers and local residents in Wollongong and Port Kembla on the New South Wales south coast spoke with the *World Socialist Web Site* this week about BlueScope Steel's decision to shut down its export division and axe up to 1,400 workers' jobs. The decision is part of a wave of job cuts now sweeping through the Australian manufacturing industry with an estimated 100,000 workers set to lose their jobs in the next few months.
