

SEP presidential candidate speaks on Wisconsin public radio

After a successful public meeting at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee last week, Socialist Equality Party presidential candidate Jerry White was interviewed by 89.7 WUWM, the Milwaukee Public Radio Station.
