On “US deployment of stealth bombers escalates military standoff in Korea”

Lt Col Catherine Wilkinson, a Pentagon spokesperson, was reported as saying “The United States will not accept North Korea as a nuclear state; nor will we stand by while it seeks to develop a nuclear-armed missile that can target the United States.” Given that North Korea is supposed to have detonated at least one nuclear device and put a satellite into orbit, this statement amounts to a public declaration that the US military intends to attack North Korea. And sooner rather than later. A war that will be potentially far more dangerous than either an attack on Iran or Iraq; both China and Russia have borders with North Korea and there is no indication that the US intends to restrict its military options to conventional weapons.
