The example of a victorious socialist revolution politically radicalized the working class throughout the world, inspiring the masses with the possibility of an alternative to capitalism and imperialism.

In the aftermath of the dissolution of the Soviet Union in 1991, the propagandists of the ruling class declared that this represented the decisive triumph of capitalism, the so-called "End of History." However, as capitalismm confronts its greatest crisis since the 1930s, the events of 1917 once again acquire immense relevance.
