Video: Auto workers defend Detroit Institute of Arts

In Detroit, there is deep opposition to the sale of the artwork from the Detroit Institute of Arts. Emergency Manager Kevyn Orr has threatened to sell the museum's world-famous masterpieces to pay off the city's big bondholders.
