# The election of Syriza in Greece: Marxism vs. the pseudo-left

A lecture series by David North (April 8 - 22)

The recent elections in Greece are of immense international significance. The Coalition of the Radical Left, or Syriza, was able to exploit the mass discontent produced by brutal austerity measures imposed since 2010 on the Greek population. Within days of the election, however, Syriza completely repudiated its program and adopted as its own the demands of the European banks and political institutions.

To understand the nature and role of Syriza, it is necessary to examine the trajectory of a whole international trend of left—or, more accurately, pseudoleft—organizations. In the aftermath of the Second World War, and particularly following the events of 1968, this tendency repudiated Marxism, developing a "left" politics that was increasingly divorced from, and opposed to, the working class and socialism.

With the elevation of Syriza in Greece to the pinnacles of state power, these forces have been fully integrated into the state. They are playing an increasingly critical role not only in the implementation of the dictates of the banks but also in the promotion of imperialism—including support for the US-backed operations in Syria, Ukraine, Libya and Iraq.

In this lecture, *World Socialist Web Site* International Editorial Board Chairman David North will examine the politics, social interests and theoretical conceptions behind the rightward trajectory of Syriza and its international backers and promoters.
