

Video: Protesters speak at anti-Trump march in San Diego, California

This past Saturday, thousands of protesters took to the streets in California cities and throughout the United States.

In San Diego, members of the Socialist Equality Party and International Youth and Students for Social Equality spoke to workers and young people attending anti-Trump protests in that city.
