Indika Perera and Suranga Piyawardena, the president and secretary of the Podujana Pragathishili Save Sangamaya (PPSS), which is affiliated to the ruling Sri Lanka Podujana Peramuna, violently attacked Dehin and Fernando, causing severe injuries.
